Job details are easily accessible

Sage Line 100 has an intuitive user interface, which allows you to call up the full details of your jobs quickly and easily. A simple enquiry will tell you such details as the costs incurred to date for each cost category, amount invoiced for the job and any payments received.

Integrates fully with other Line 100 modules

By working with the Stock, Purchase Ledger, Cash Book and Invoicing modules, Sage Line 100 Job Costing ensures that as costs are recorded, the appropriate adjustments are made throughout your Line 100 system. You can also integrate the Job Costing module with Sage Payroll and Sage Payroll Professional, enabling you to avoid duplication of entries on time sheets.

Comprehensive budgeting

You can specify budgets for each cost classification level; reports display variances against budget and also indicate future projected costs based on budget yet to be expended. This allows you to keep tight control over your costs for each project.

Phasing

You can divide a job into multiple phases with invoices raised for each phase as required; you also have full budgetary control for each phase.

Flexible invoicing

Specify the items and values to be invoiced at any stage. Backing sheets are produced giving the required level of detail to support each invoice.

Manage tasks simultaneously

The convenience of being able to execute a number of tasks simultaneously is just one of the many facets of Sage Line 100 that increases productivity and ease of use. For example, you can review the budgets for a job while recording time sheets.

A comprehensive, easy to use help system

Flexible reporting

A range of standard reports can be run from Sage Line 100 Job Costing - for example, actuals versus budget, work in progress, and job profitability. You can also create new reports to suit your individual requirements.
